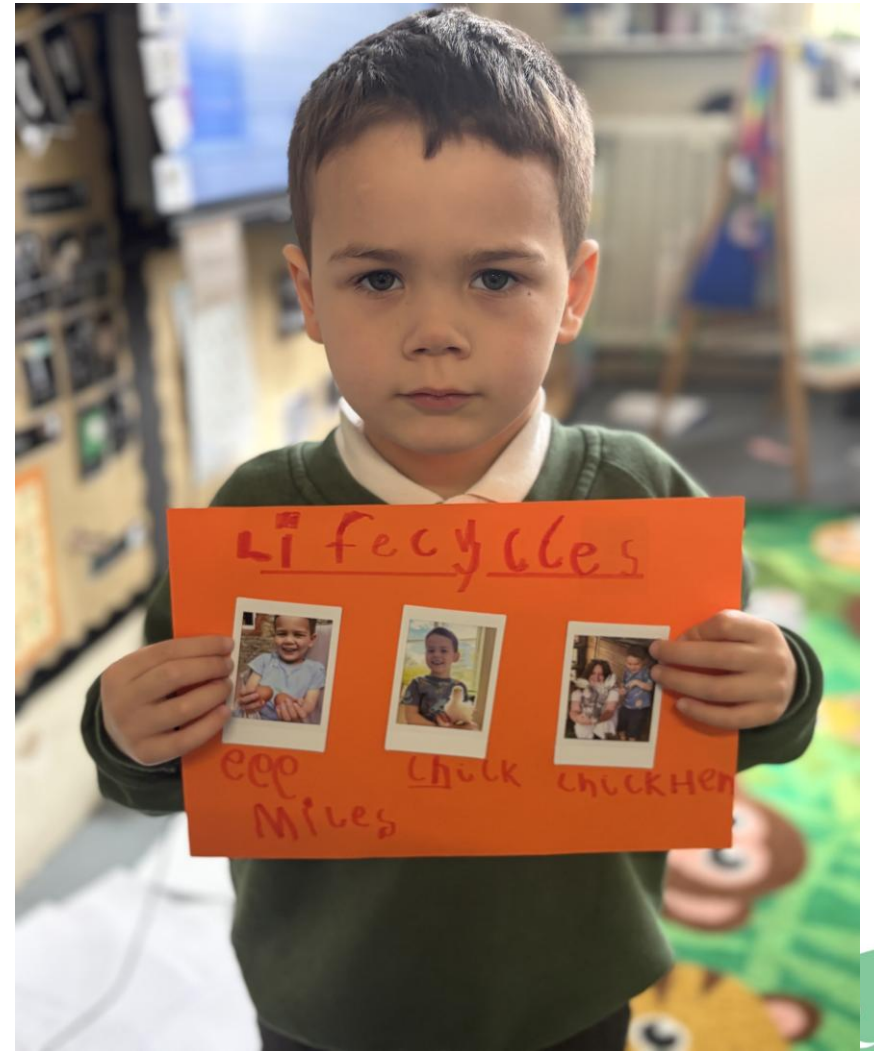

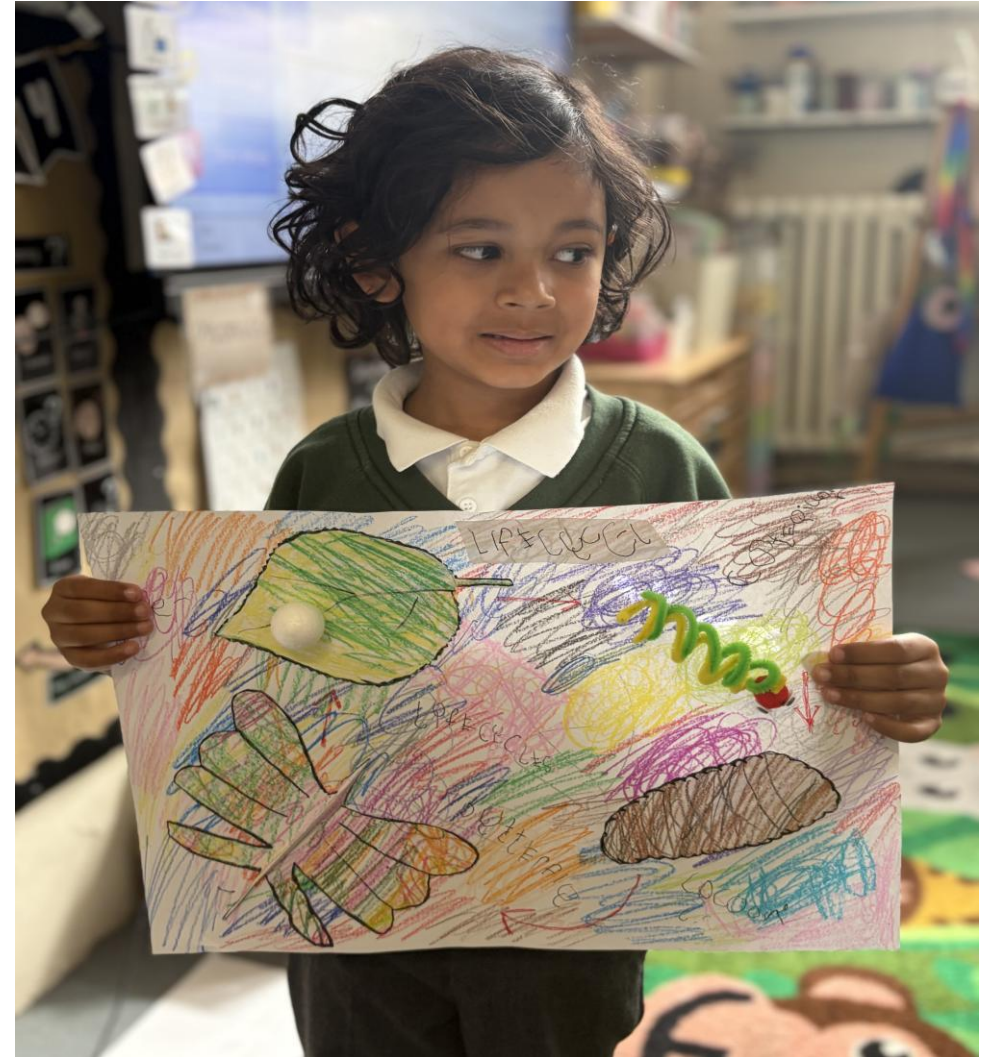
Wisteria

about a butterfly.



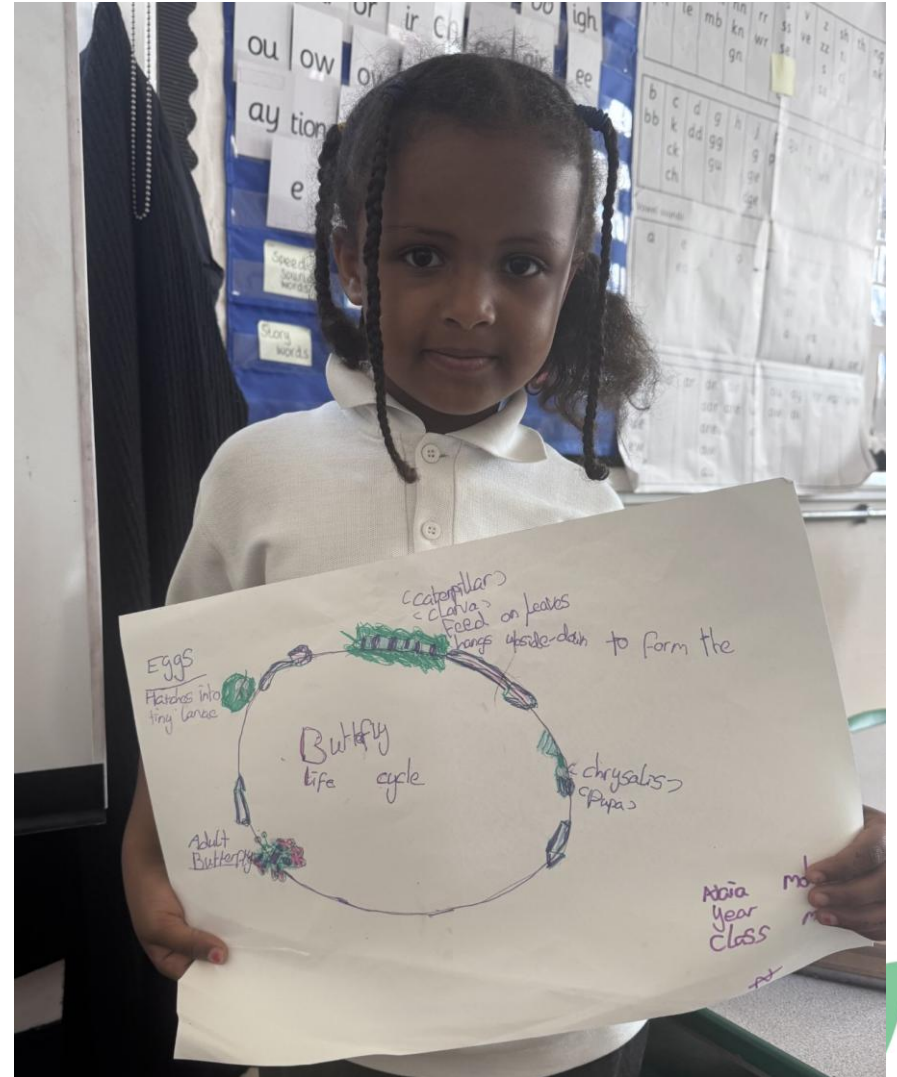
Chestnut

I went to the museum to find out about the life cycle of different animals. It was so much fun. Did you know some animals lay eggs.



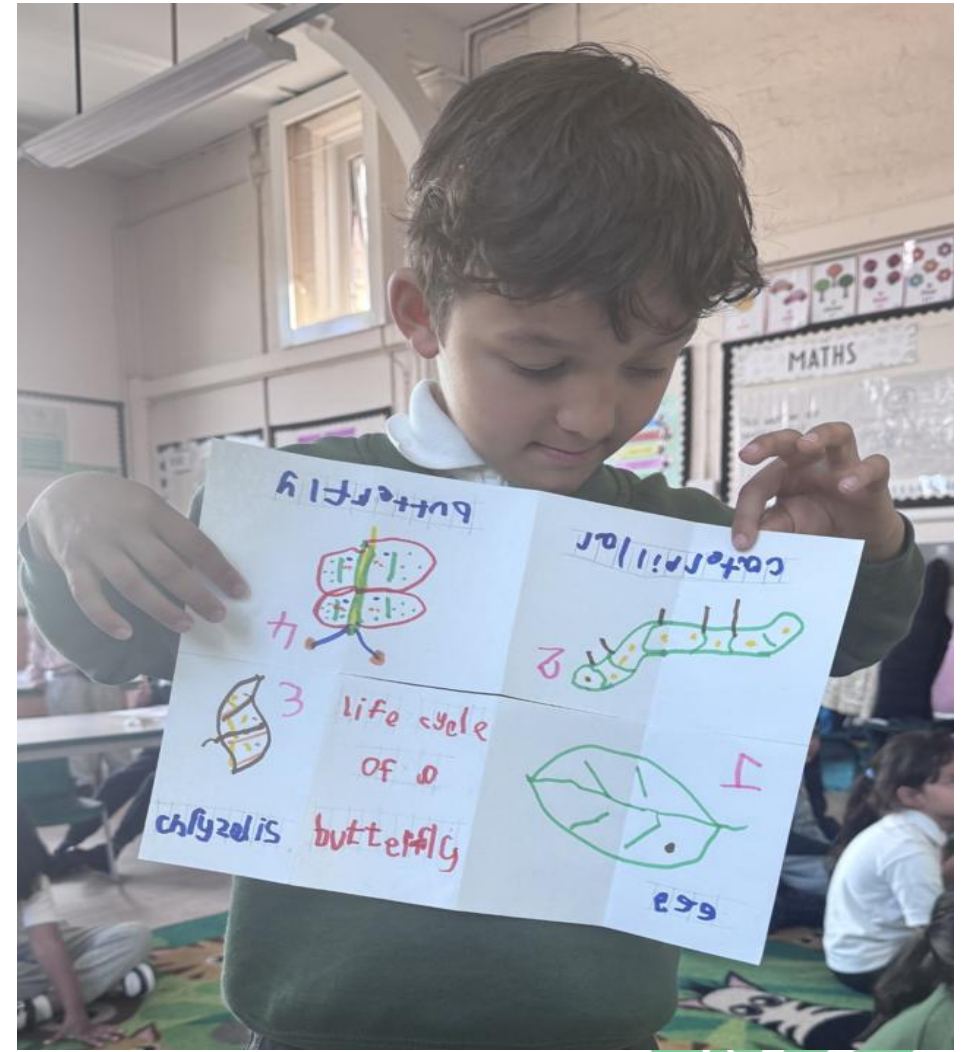
Mulberry

I did it by myself. I was drawing the life cycle of a butterfly. I used pen and paper.



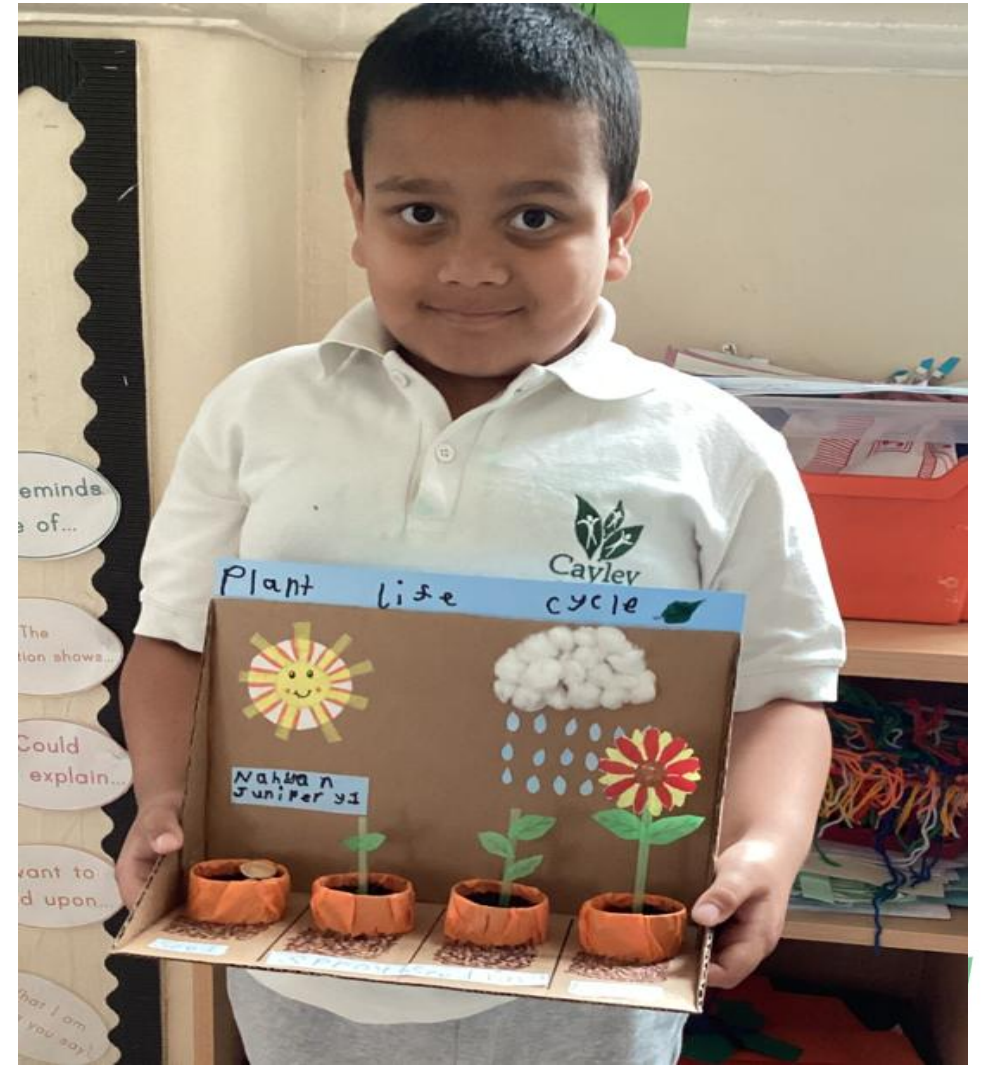
Mulberry

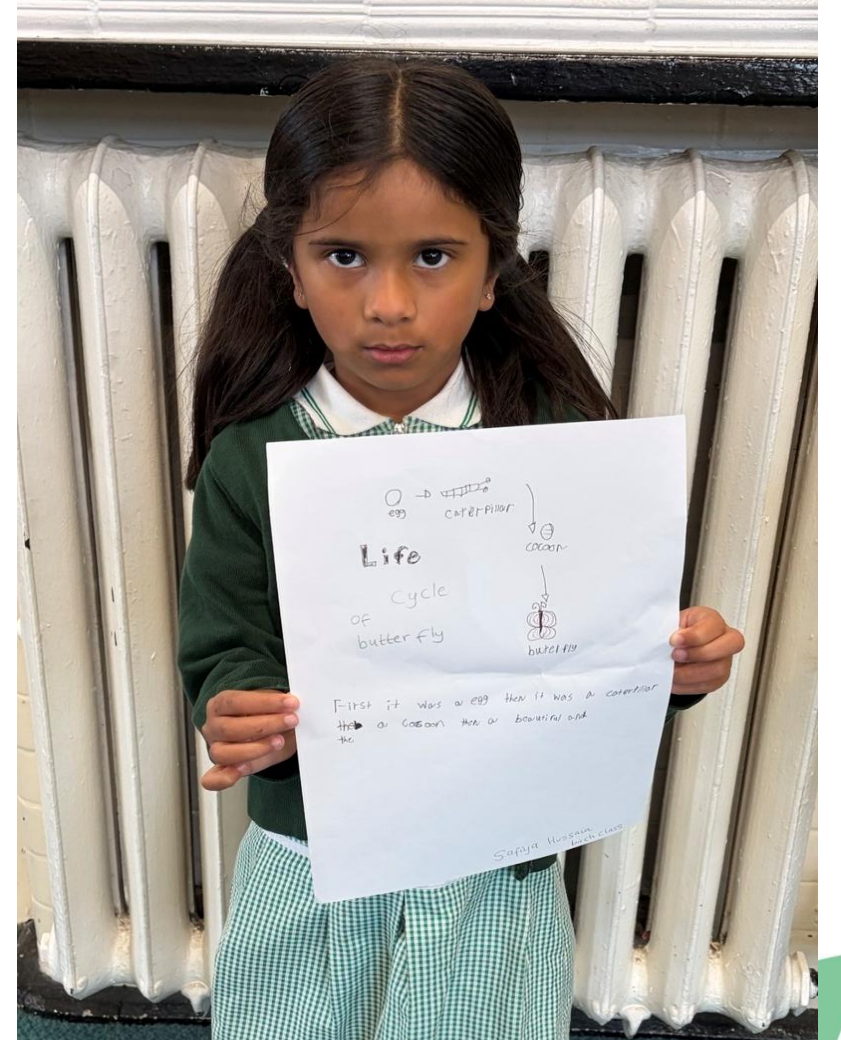

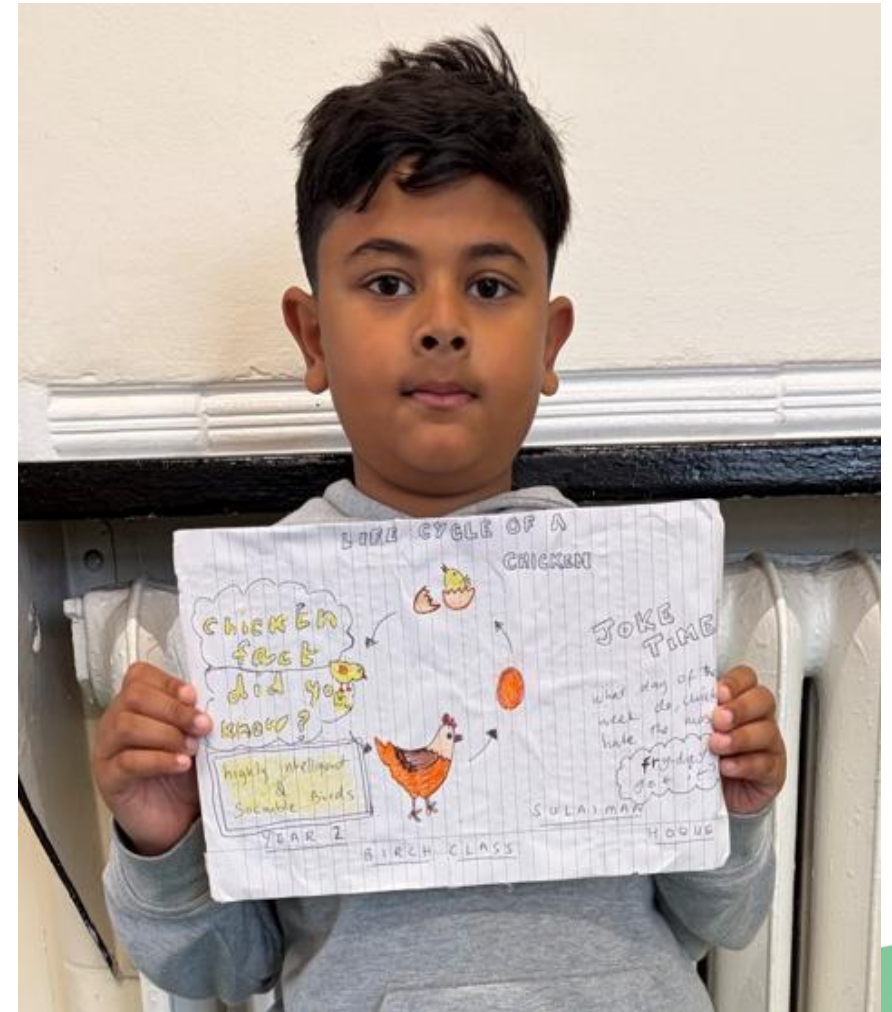
Birch

I made a ladybird life cycle. My mum helped me. First comes the eggs. Next the larva. Then comes the pupa and finally comes the adult ladybird.



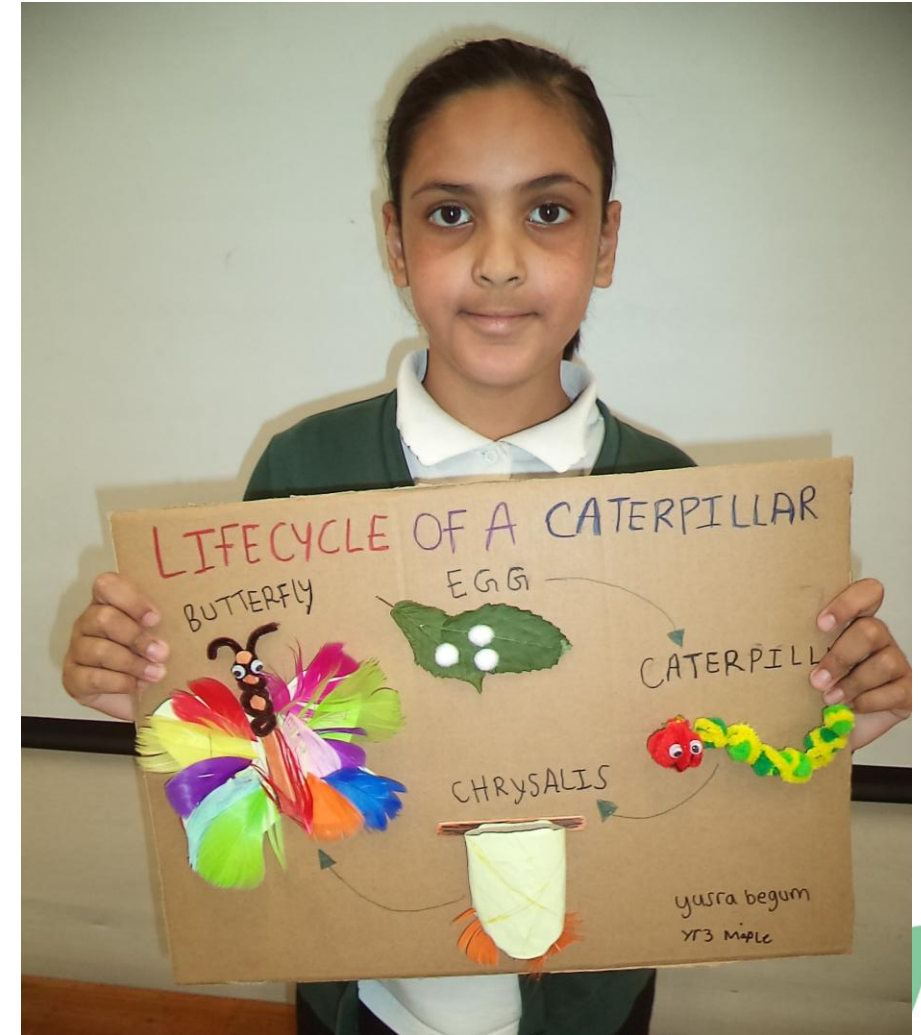
Maple

I made a Lion King Family homework with my sister. My sister had to copy a picture of the Lion King but I painted the sun and it looked like a circle.



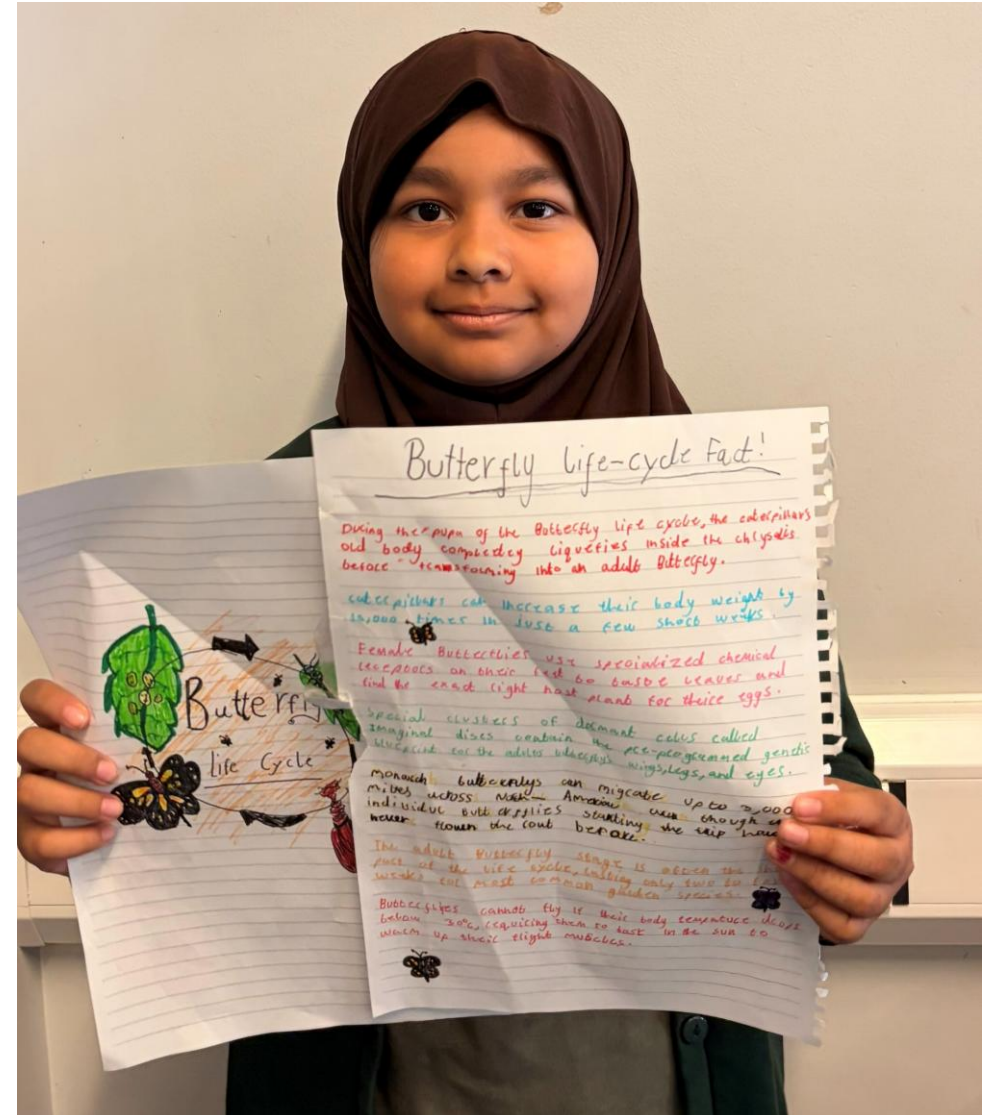

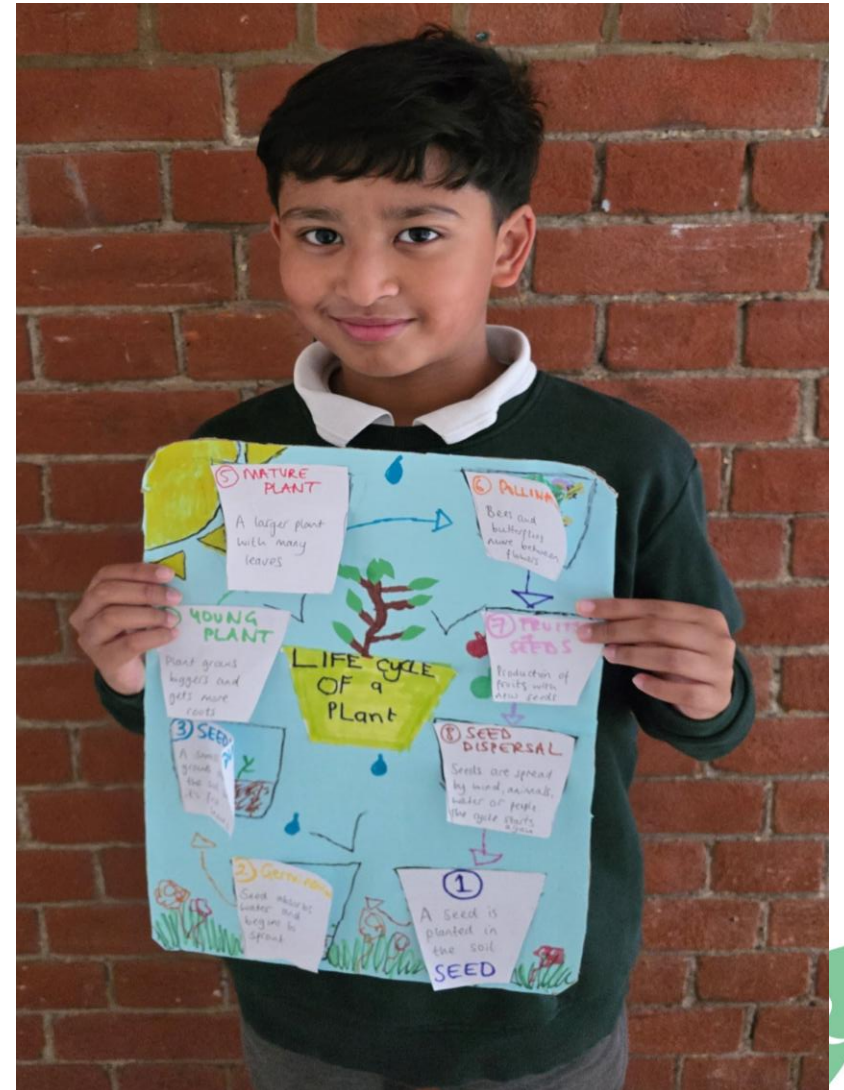
Aspen

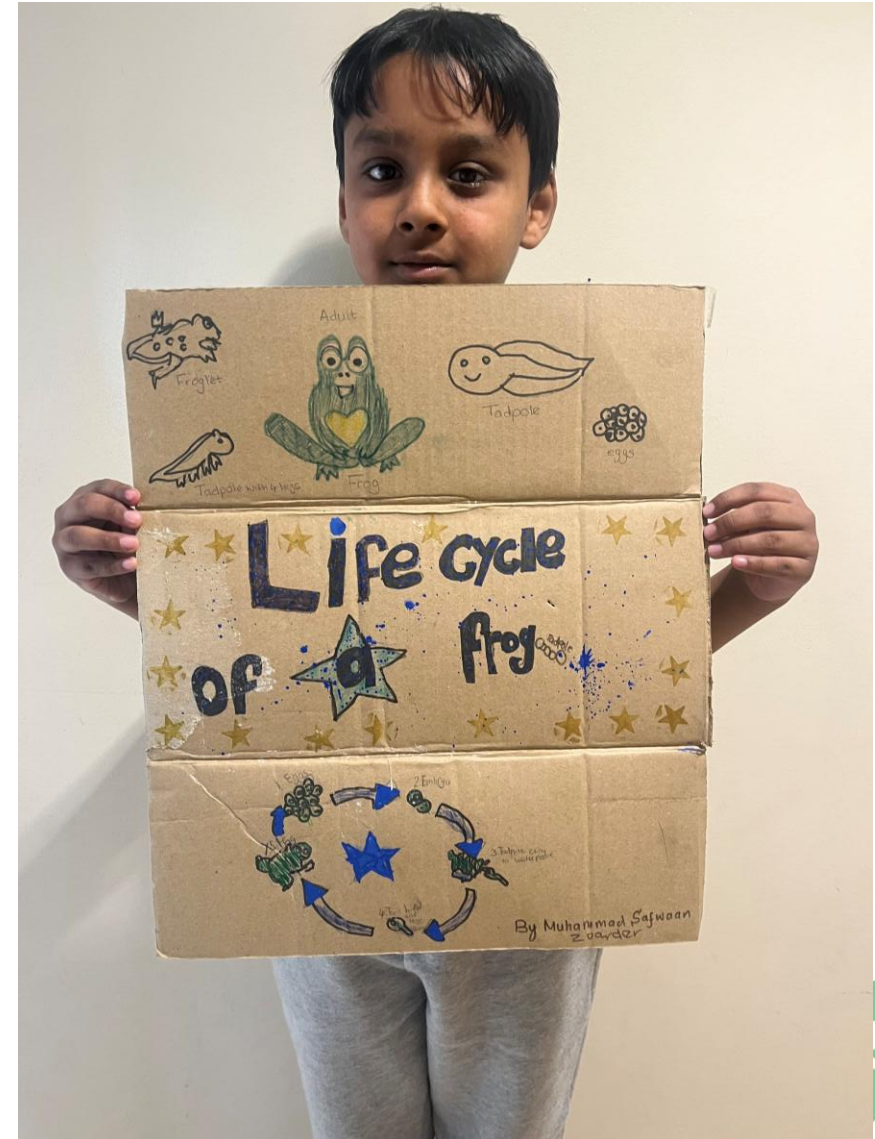
Beech

Carob

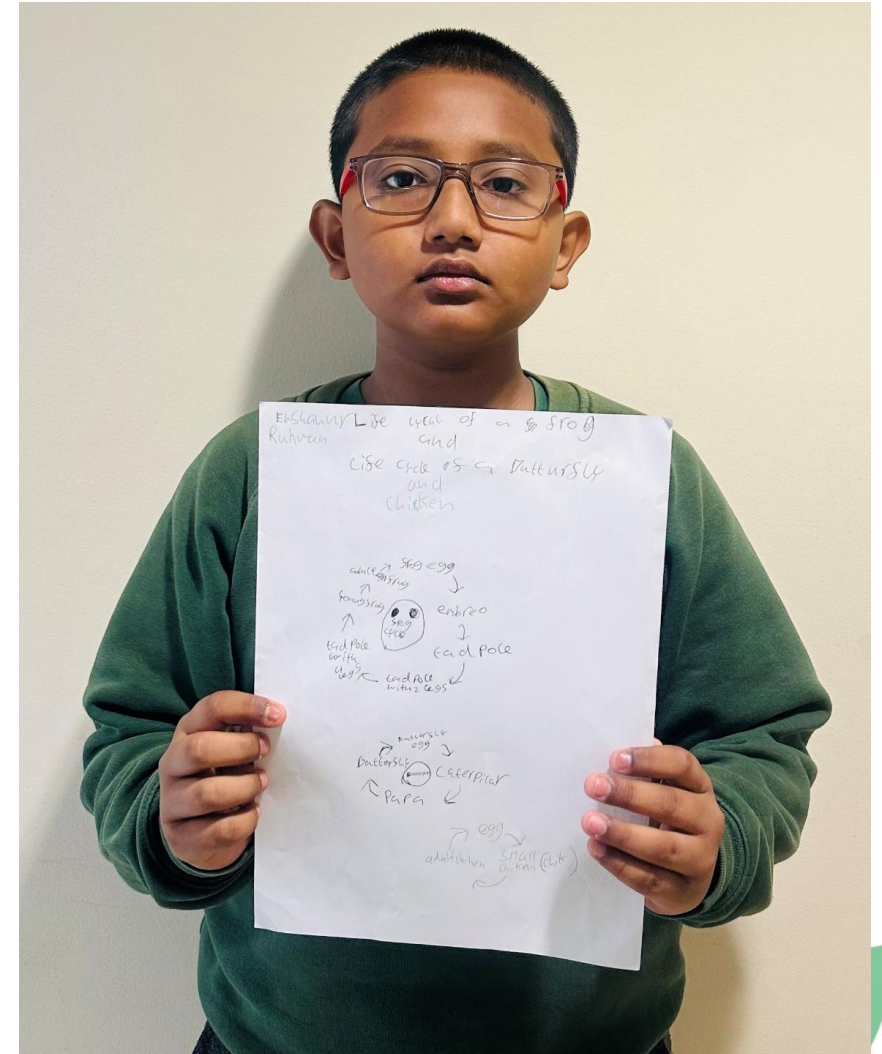
